SUMMARY.

The resurrection of Jesus means that the dominion of death no longer has power, the end of a dominion of evil and the beginning of a dominion of love and goodness, the beginning of a new hope, and the extermination of a kingdom of doubt and uncertainty to one of faith and trust. It gives us hope that even though we may have difficulties in this life, we can have hope that we will live with Him for eternity

SUNDAY'S TEACHING

- What did the Holy Spirit speak to you about Sunday's teaching?

2 Corinthians 5:16-18

- What stands out to you most about this passage?
- Why do you think Paul equates following Jesus with a birth?
- What, or how, does it make you reflect the fact that our way of living is what demonstrates our salvation?

PRACTICE AS A COMMUNITY.

Today, we want to create a space for you to reflect personally on what the death and resurrection of Jesus means in your life.

First, take a few minutes and simply write down what feelings and thoughts pass through you, knowing that you deserved to die, but that the only person in the world who did not deserve to die was the one who made the decision to die for you

- Be as honest as possible. If it makes you indifferent, write it down. If it doesn't generate anything for you, write it down. If it brings you joy, write it down

Now, think and write what God may be trying to tell you through those emotions and thoughts

- If you feel indifferent, God may suddenly be telling you that you are not sufficiently aware of your sin. If it brings you guilt, it may be that God is trying to tell you that you still have to understand what grace means. Be honest, and let the Holy Spirit speak to you through this question. If you give it space, it can reveal a lot to your life.

Lastly, reflect and then answer this question. Does my lifestyle reflect that I am a new person in Jesus? Why or why not?

Let's end with a minute of silence, reflecting and thinking about what Jesus did for each of us on the cross
