SUMMARY.

Jesus shows us what it means for him to have a relationship with us, and it is that of a wedding. A very close relationship between the groom and the bride. A relationship that is based on loyalty and fidelity until the day of marriage. We will go through hard seasons, and that is why Revelation challenges us to remain pure, holy, and in love until the day of the wedding.

- What did the Holy Spirit speak to you (or got your attention) about Sunday's teaching?

Revelations 19:6-9

- Did you know that there is going to be a wedding in heaven?
- Who do you think are going to be invited to this wedding? Who do you think will NOT be invited to this wedding?
- Do you think it's possible to go to church and not be invited to this wedding?

PRACTICE AS A COMMUNITY.

For many years tradition has taught us that by saying a prayer we are invited to the great party that is going to be in heaven, and even though it is true that we are invited when we accept Jesus as our savior, there is also another reality. Those who actually have Jesus as their lord and savior dress in "the highest quality clothing that represents the good deeds of God's holy people."

The invitation for today's practice is to personally analyze if our way of living and our actions really represent holiness and commitment to Jesus like that of a bride to a groom.

First

- Take a couple of seconds to describe what a boyfriend and girlfriend relationship is like

Second

- Take a couple of minutes to describe what your relationship with Jesus is like. Be as honest as possible

Third

- Now compare the two points above. Write about how IS your relationship with Jesus similar to that of a boyfriend and a girlfriend. And write down how your relationship with Jesus is NOT like that of a boyfriend and a girlfriend

Fourth

- The key word between a boyfriend and a girlfriend is **commitment**. Which means to give your all through thick and thin; and that's what Jesus asks of us, because it is what he has given for us
- Take a couple of minutes to be honest with yourself and with Jesus about your commitment to Him
 - Do you really want to commit to him?
 - Do your actions reflect your commitment to him?
 - Do your lifestyle and actions really show that you have a relationship with Jesus?
 - What changes should you make to demonstrate that commitment?

This week's practice

The practice this week is to let your actions reflect your commitment to Jesus. To start making the necessary changes in your lifestyle, habits, and actions, to demonstrate your commitment
