SUMMARY.

The Spirit of God takes the prophet in a supernatural experience, taken from the natural and carried in the spirit to see what God was seeing and to hear what God was hearing. The people of Israel were suffering the wounds of exile, they had been thrown out of their own home, their possessions had been taken away, and foreign peoples had attacked and wounded them, not only physically but also in their soul. Everyone was aware of the crisis that Israel was suffering, but only God had the vision to recognize the true condition of the wounded heart of his people. Only God could pierce the flesh and bones (appearance) to understand how serious the condition of his people was
