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BEGIN IN PRAYER AND WORSHIP.

Pray asking the Holy Spirit to lead and guide your time together.

READ THIS SUMMARY.

Living and building an environment in our home that we enjoy does not happen by accident; It must be something on purpose. And God left us a guide and values in his word.

Honesty, truth, and purity are the foundations that will sustain and build your family. Where each of its members is formed and educated with the fundamental principles of the word of God.

TALK ABOUT SUNDAY'S TEACHING.

READ THE BIBLE TOGETHER.

DO THIS PRACTICE AS A COMMUNITY RIGHT NOW.

Tonight we are going to take the first step to build our family on the foundations of the word of God. If you already have a family, this is the best time to correct and bring in a new culture. If you haven't started your family yet, even better because you can start creating the culture even before you have your family.

Now the practice.

1. Step One: Read the four bases again

- The word of God
- Truth
- Honesty
- Confession - Forgiveness - Reconciliation.

2. Step Two: Identify the foundation you have the most to grow.

- Make a circle, mark, or put a mark in which of those four bases is what you struggle with the most in your personal life.

3. Step Three: Identify the foundation your family needs to grow the most from.

- Do the same as point number two but now based on your family.
- Your family is with the people who live under the same roof.
- If you live alone, then do it based on your family of origin (your parents or the people you grew up with).

4. Step Four: Identify a personal change.

- Now write a practical step that you are going to take to change point two (the base with which you battle the most)
- If it's the word of God, Do the church bible reading plan.

- If it is the truth, commit yourself not to tell lies, however small they may be.
- Write just one to focus on.

5. Step Five: Identify a change in your family.

- Do the same as the previous step but now focused on your family.
- Avoid focusing on the bad things other people do. Write one step that **YOU CAN DO** to bring that culture change to your family.
- If it is the word of God, you can suggest that everyone read a psalm before going to sleep together.
- If it is forgiveness, start by asking someone in your family for forgiveness.

This week's practice is to take the two practical steps you wrote down. We recommend that you put a date when you are going to do it so that you do not forget.
