PRACTICE IN COMMUNITY

This week's practice is going to be easy to start, but a little more challenging to finish

You are going to read the passage individually once again, underlining what catches your attention

Next, you are going to ask the Holy Spirit to bring to mind a person to whom you should show yourself as a friend. Remember that it may even be a person who is not your friend. It may be that God wants you to take a meaningful action toward that person, such as forgiving or confessing something (without necessarily having a close relationship). Do not try to "over-spiritualize" this practice. Trust that the first person that comes to mind is because The Holy Spirit put them there
